#### **Enrollment**

Alview: 160; Dairyland 241 Total: 401

- 1. Dairyland Portable Update:
  - i. We've contracted with R-H construction to do the earthwork for the cement pad. After a meeting to review the scope of the work, they will begin the project next week. I also spoke to the owner about the exclusions listed on the proposal and most are standard language.
  - ii. We're also reviewing the plans and proposal from Tim Trull Electric for installing conduit, boxes, etc. to connect to the new buildings.
- 2. Alview Project Update: After a meeting with SchoolWorks last week we learned that we can apply for state TK facilities funds in two different programs:

#### a. Universal TK-K Grant:

i. Applications are available starting March 1<sup>st</sup>. We plan to apply but last year, only hardship districts were awarded state funds. This year, applications will be prioritized based on additional hardship districts and unduplicated percentages. If we were to get the award, we could possibly receive the funding in less than a year.

#### b. State matching new construction funds:

i. We would match 50% but wait-times for funding have been taking between 3 and 4 years.

In the meantime, we received quotes from Global Modular on the Alview Building:

- \$316,000 for a refurbished 48 x 40 unit (1920 square feet consisting of two 960 ft classrooms with restrooms carved out of classroom space).
- \$481,000 for a new 60 x 40 unit (two 960 ft classrooms with a 420 ft additional unit for restrooms and storage)
- Amount budgeted in LCAP: \$235K
- Next steps: Finding an architect.
- 3. Our access control project at Dairyland is nearing completion. Our final step is to connect the front door camera with the new monitors that we placed in rooms 1 & 2. Hoffman will be getting us some fobs to use for practice and will be here on 10/10 to train staff.
