- 1. Alview Shade Structure Update: Architect has a DSA Counter appointment scheduled for 8/15; once approved, Zoom Recreation will start the production; lead time is approximately 10 weeks plus an additional week for installation.
  - a. Architect has created a site plan that includes a stage/platform, ramp and stairs.

- i. DSA requires a topographic survey—Gonzalez Architects recommended we award the project to CVES.
- ii. After the topographic survey, DSA also requires a certification letter from a geotechnical engineer that verifies the "applicability of available soil values" since Alview School is in a flood zone. Based on the architect's recommendation, we contracted with RMA GeoScience.
- 2. The new Alview classrooms are furnished and ready for the first day of school.
- 3. There was not enough time to complete the Alview fencing and concrete project; it will be forwarded to summer of 2025.
- 4. Teachers were back for training today; we covered expectations, class lists, safety plans and academic files. The new wellness coach discussed her role/ referral process and Mrs. Fautheree provided training on the new Smart Boards. We have mandated training Wednesday as well as the staff luncheon. Teachers' first week back will conclude on Thursday with Science curriculum training and the Back to School Barbecue.
